LOT 168 - Springfield Model 1861 Rifle-Musket in .58 Caliber



Description

No serial numbers are visible. This was the standard issue rifle of the Union Army at the time. Lockplate is marked "U.S. Springfield" "1864" and has the US eagle mark. Marked "V" and "P" on the left side of the barrel with an additional, but undeterminable mark under the P. Each of the 3 bands holding the barrel is marked "U". Inspectors cartouche (Believed to read "E.J.") is visible in the wood on the left side of the stock. Marked "M" on the wood on the bottom of the shoulder part of the stock. Typical expected wear, nice original condition. Hammer and trigger mechanisms work as they should. Includes new reproduction leather sling.
